Clearly this estate is a non sustainable settlement under the only numerate guidelines within the Leeds Core Strategy. It is a settlement isolated from Wetherby by a 6 lane motorway. Nearly all travel will be by car, contrary to the current Climate Change Strategy of Leeds City Council.
